# 2011 - Salmon Creek Ravine and Shorewood Park Work Parties

Join us for work parties nearly every month this year. This is your opportunity to participate in a group effort to rid the Park of invasive plants like

English Holly, English Ivy, English Laurel and Himalayan Blackberry. The environmental reward comes when we restore the Park to the natural ecology with native plants.

We'll provide tools and gloves (bring your own gloves if you wish) and a specific project to work on for 2 hours.

What you don't read about is that members of the team released about 10,000 of the Coho fry in Salmon Creek. The fry are now at two locations far upstream of the treatment plant. Coho spend at least 18 months in fresh water before heading out to the marine waters. The Shorewood Community Members have been working with Trout Unlimited for years now to see Salmon Recovery in Salmon Creek.

On Saturday, March 12, 2011; members of the Shorewood Community Club braved the elements to do some beach replanting for the trees we removed last year. Ten Garry oaks were planted to help stabilize the beach. Thanks to those who helped with the planting in this weather.
